Karrayili is an Aboriginal-directed training and community service agency serving the Fitzroy Valley in WA. It was established in the 1980's by Aboriginal people and has played a significant role in the development of agencies and communities across the Fitzroy Valley.

It is seeking an experienced person to lead it through the next stage of its development, build on its successes and achieve its goals.

Karrayili is an organisation in transition. In 2014, it incurred financial losses. A turnaround strategy in 2015 has positioned it for growth in 2016.

There are currently three program areas four areas of business activity (Table 1).
